St. Luke Presbyterian Church's Current COVID-19 Strategy to Protect Our Church Family

Hello St Luke members and friends!

As we are learning to social distance, becoming more accustomed to wearing masks, and finding ways to engage with one another in low risk environments, your session has changed some of our Pandemic Procedures with a few more options.

Our building remains open only to essential activities and previously scheduled small groups, but we have expanded our options for scheduling. Each day two small groups may meet in the building, as long as they are meeting either two hours apart or in separate areas of the building and using separate entrances. All groups must wear masks, practice social distancing, and schedule times with the church office. Starting September 1, you will be able to reserve a time to visit some prayer stations that will be set up from the Tower door and through to the Sanctuary. More information will be in your newsletter. Small group information continues to be available in your bulletin and newsletters.

The most exciting news is that we will be preparing for an in-person outdoor worship service on Sunday, September 6. The worship committee and I will be sharing more details in your bulletin and newsletter as the day approaches, but you can plan to pack your lawn chairs and head down to the church early in the morning, assuming the weather holds out!

All worship services will remain available on both Facebook and YouTube.
