

#### <u> CImportant Deadline</u>

As the end of 2023 approaches, please remember that St. Luke closes its fiscal year on December 31. All contributions to be applied to the current year must be received by 3:30 p.m. on Friday, December 29. If you made in-kind donations, send your receipts to the church office so that those may be acknowledged as well.

Please know that donations made through the church's online platform take *several* days to be deposited in St. Luke's bank account. Any online contributions to be applied to 2023 must be <u>deposited</u> in St. Luke's account by the close of the banking day on December 31; therefore, if you need to be certain that your gift is recorded for 2023, it is best to bring a check by the church office.

In the first full week of December, you will receive a Giving Statement (by email) that covers the period of January 1 to November 30. The purpose of this statement is to allow you to review that we have properly recorded all of your 2023-to-date gifts as you directed. It also gives you an opportunity to correct any errors or to catch up before the final 12-month statement is released in January 2024.

Your offerings, tithes, and special gifts make the ministries, missions, and programs of St. Luke Presbyterian Church possible.
